Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

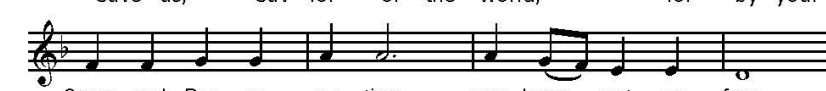

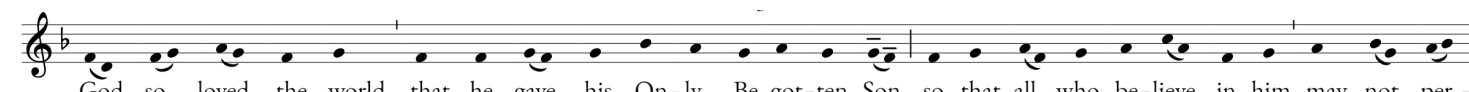

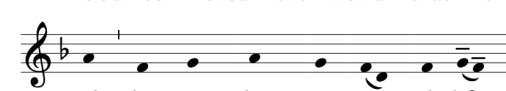
