## THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

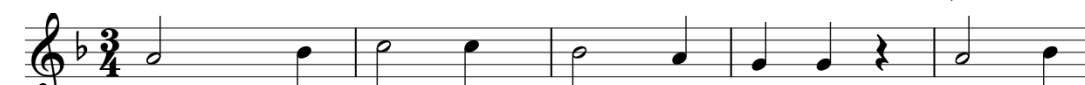

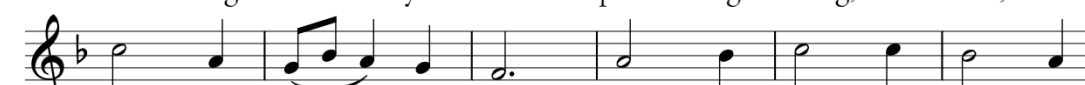

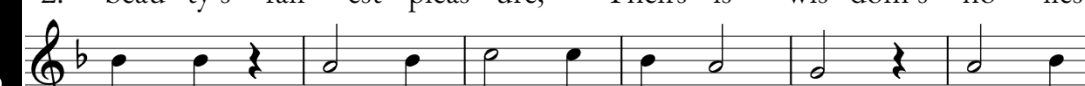
