
ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

- 1. At the Lamb's high feast we sing Praise to our victorious King, Who hath washed us in the tide Flowing from his piercèd side; Praise we him, whose love divine, Gives his sacred Blood for wine, Gives his Body for the feast, Christ the Victim, Christ the Priest.
- 2. Where the Paschal Blood is poured, Death's dark angel sheathes his sword; Israel's hosts triumphant go Through the wave that drowns the foe. Praise we Christ, whose Blood was shed, Paschal Victim, Paschal Bread; With sincerity and love Eat we manna from above.
- 3. Mighty Victim from on high! Hell's fierce pow'rs beneath thee lie; Thou hast conquer'd in the fight, Thou hast brought us life and light: Now no more can death appall, Now no more the grave enthrall; Thou hast opened paradise, And in thee thy saints shall rise.



Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed


