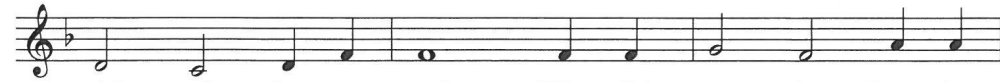
PRAYER TO ST. MICHAEL

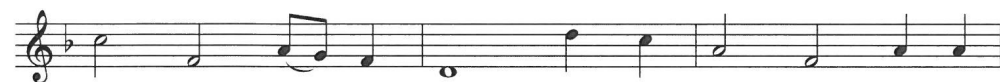

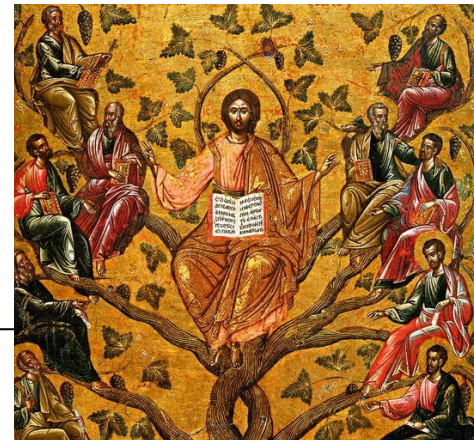

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

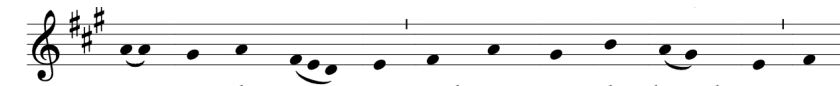
