Ten thousand years and then forevermore.

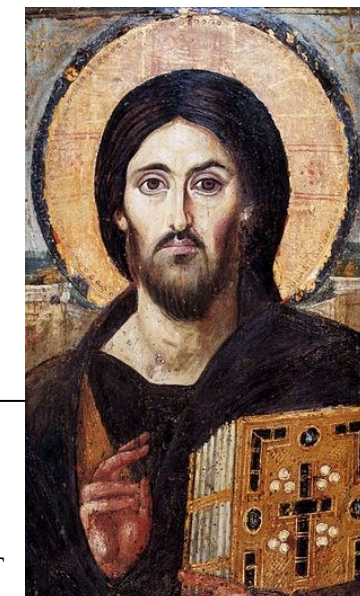

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed
