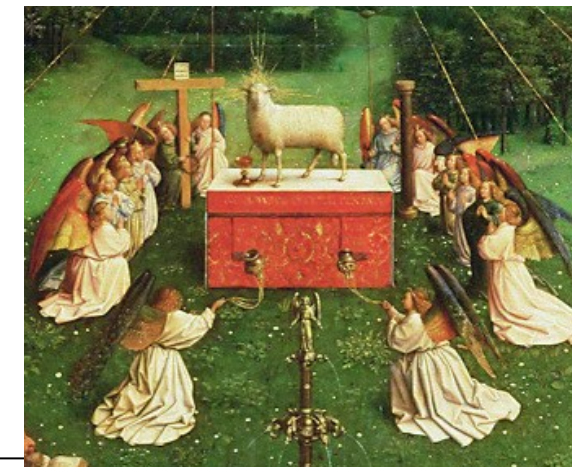

Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed

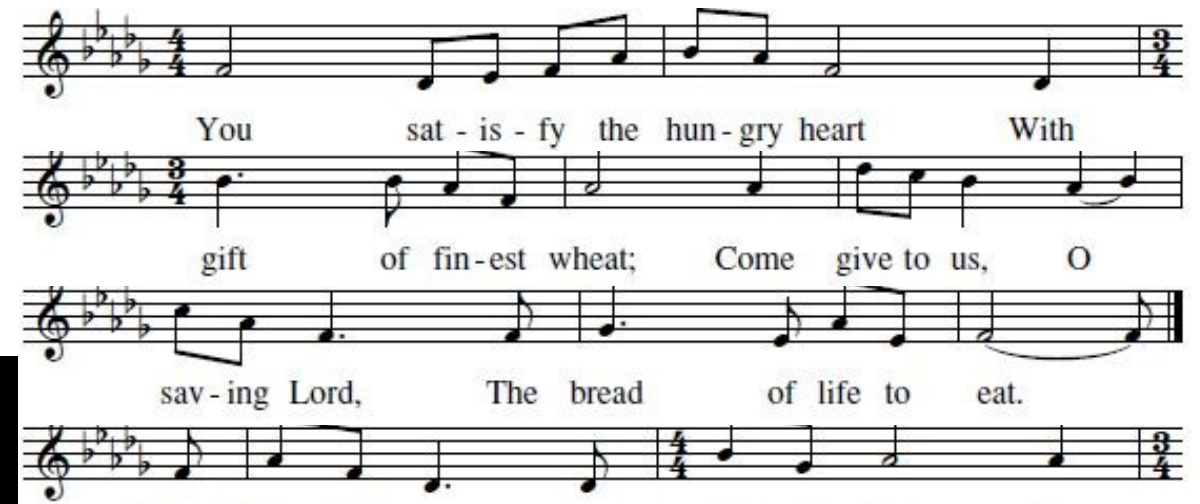

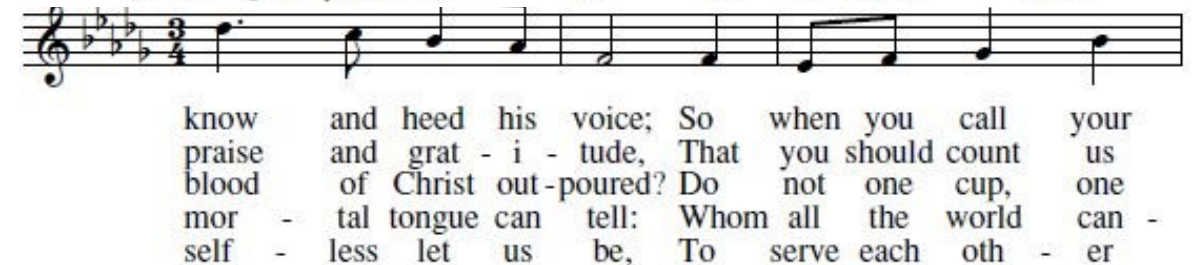
